On Monday, 2 August, the students of Year 3 walked to Duggan Dam to investigate the quality of the water in our local area. This exciting initiative is sponsored by Nature Conservation Margaret River. The excursion was led by Michelle Keppel who explained the important role that students have as 'Citizen Scientists'.

Students were asked to survey the area and predict the healthiness of the waterway. Following their predictions students sampled the water by collecting macroinvertebrates and other lifeforms from the dam.
